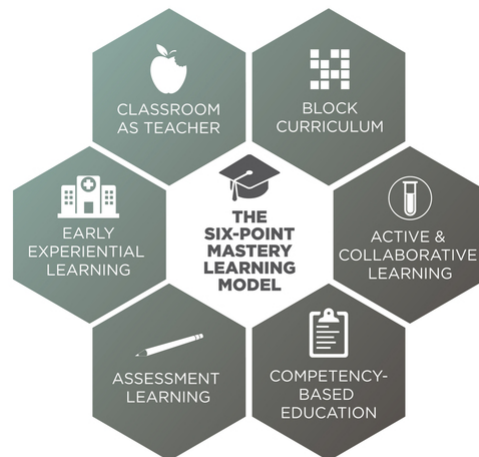
Faculty Council Activities Launched
