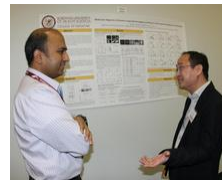

Dr. Balan is also Senior Lecturer at the School of Management at the University of South Australia Business School. He has an extensive industry background, and is active in teaching, research, and industry and community engagement. Dr. Balan offered an interactive session where he collected audience feedback thrown at him (see photos) and provided approaches to promote student buy-in and accountability to the group process. The session was well received and additional faculty development offerings are being scheduled.



College of Medicine Presence at the Second Annual Research Day

The Roseman University 2nd Annual Research Day took place at the Henderson campus on March 2nd and included substantial college representation. The program combined a keynote address, research posters, and oral poster presentations. Curriculum Planning Update

The planning teams for the ten

courses of the year 1 curriculum are revising the first iteration of the courses. At this time, sequencing and coordination of content across the courses and years has undergone a first review where unplanned redundancies were addressed (e.g. the same topic addressed in multiple courses was assigned to the appropriate course, allowing other courses to rearrange their content). The team leadership recently met to review the next steps related to refining the sessions in terms of time and teaching methods. In parallel, teams are more clearly defining a set of session-level learning objectives. This part of the year 1 planning activity will end by May 15th. The course planning teams for the year 2 courses will be formed and the process applied for the year 1 courses repeated for the year 2 courses.
